

# Believer's Youth Camp Rules

It is expedient that all camp rules be obeyed to prevent being sent home!

- 1.) Each camper planning to stay at the camp must register prior to going to the designated dorm.
- 2.) If any damages do occur, the responsible party must pay the repairs!
- 3.) Campers are expected to keep their rooms clean and personal belongings in order.
- 4.) Campers are required to attend all services and all scheduled activities.
- 5.) All medication must be checked in at time of registration for the nurse's record.
- 6.) Everyone shall wear shoes while on the grounds. According to the campground's insurance, flip flops and shower shoes are not considered shoes.
- 7.) No camper person is to leave grounds without properly notifying the staff and such permission being granted.
- 8.) "Modesty & Humility" are the key words in dress and deed.
  - Brothers: keep sweat pants in the cabins, not out in public. Also, no skinny jeans or holey jeans.
  - Sisters: please have modest sleeves and necklines. No slacks. No tight, clingy, or form fitting skirts/dresses. No sheer or see-through clothing. No skirts or dresses with splits.
- 9.) No refunds without written notice prior to June 17, 2017 . (2 weeks prior to camp)
- 10.) Campers are required to be in their cabins, devotions completed and quiet by 11:00pm. (Except for the Holy Spirit working)
- 11.) All cell phones must be turned off during service times and before devotion time.
- 12.) Please do not post photos to social media during the week of camp.
- 13.) Campers must remain in central camp areas and may not travel to the cabin or RV areas except by special permission from the staff.
- 14.) Campers are not to stay in cottages or RVs without the approval of the staff.
- 15.) No camper is allowed outside of sleeping areas after lights out.
- 16.) It is your responsibility to bring personal belongings home. Items left behind will not be returned.

Split skirts, clingy, see-through clothes  
No Playing Cards  
Pellet guns, Knives, Roller Blades, Skateboards, Bikes  
No drums without receiving prior permission
